

## Mirror Ministries responds to domestic minor sex trafficking with the love of Christ through local education, intervention, restoration, and aftercare.

Mirror Ministries was inspired by a 2010 trip to Cambodia with AIM, where our founders witnessed the horrors of child sex trafficking. Initially focused on international advocacy, they quickly realized the same evil existed in the Tri-Cities. This shifted their focus to local efforts, and in 2014, Mirror Ministries was launched.



Over the past decade, Mirror Ministries has helped over 620 survivors like Bella find hope and new life in Jesus Christ. By educating the community, intervening in trafficking situations, and providing ongoing support, Mirror Ministries breaks the cycle of exploitation and empowers survivors to rebuild their lives.

Your partnership with us enables a 24/7 hotline (509-212-9995), provides compassionate advocates ready to reach out, and empowers a team of staff and trained volunteers that are experts in trafficking interventions. From the restoration enabled by establishing Esther's Home to the miracles that take place in street ministry every month, Mirror Ministries is uniquely positioned to meet the challenge of trafficking in our community.

Our mission is transformation: for individuals affected by sex trafficking, for our community, and in the lives of those who join us in this work.

#### Reflections from Tricia MacFarlan, Executive Director

It's hard to think about it happening here... in your neighborhood schools, among the children at your church, and reaching into your home through the internet. Domestic minor sex trafficking persists because too many believe *it couldn't happen here*.

The knowledge that hundreds of children are exploited each day in our community can be overwhelming. Mirror Ministries was founded by those who felt a burden for trafficked children, driven by faith and Christ's love. Despite obstacles, we were inspired to act, and God has blessed our efforts, expanding the vision and ongoing mission.

God's love reaches through you to transform those terribly abused by others. Traffickers often treat these children as products, but you show them that they are valued and loved. You enable the miracle of transformation when you cherish the children others disregard.

You empower change for girls like Bella.\* To give testimony to the power of your participation in this ministry, Bella wanted me to share a letter she wrote about the difference we made together:

"I remember my 5th birthday. Mommy said we would have a party for me. I got a baby doll and a pretty cake. Lots of mommy's friends came. Then, Mommy told me to go wait in my room. Men came to my room. They told me, 'Happy birthday' and did things to me that hurt me. I cried. That was the end of my childhood."



"Mommy's friends came over a lot. She would bring new men to the house. Every one of them used me. WHY? Mommy and her friends would do drugs while people took turns with me. By seven, I was smoking pot with them when my mom went to jail for the first time. After that, my sisters and I were in and out of foster care. Some homes were nice; some were not."

"When I was 11, I was back with my mom, and she introduced me to other drugs. I would wake up days later, sore and dirty. At 12, Mommy sold me to a man who kept me in his garage. I watched her drive away with my sisters. At least this man let me have a puppy and only used me once a day.

When I got away from him and ran to a bus stop, I thought my prayers had been answered by a kind man who saw me and my dog and offered us a place to stay. He was not nice. He became my pimp and even killed my dog to threaten me.

I waited one day until he was passed out and I stole his car to get away. I crashed into parked cars and the police picked me up and sent me to Juvie. That ended up being a good thing. There, an advocate from Mirror Ministries heard my story and offered help. I met other girls like me. They had experiences like mine and understood my pain. They told me about Jesus and his love... and they loved me. It's made all the difference."

As Mirror Ministries celebrates entering a second decade, Bella's story inspires us to keep reaching those in need. From humble beginnings, God has blessed us, making Mirror Ministries a beacon of hope in our community.

Thank you for supporting Bella and improving the lives of so many others.



#### **Take Action**

The need for Mirror Ministries is growing rapidly. We now serve 81 active clients, but Esther's Home has room for only five girls. The bulk of our ministry takes place out in the community—reaching out in Christ's love to victims of trafficking right where they are.

Our current Outreach Center has been stretched beyond capacity. After much prayer and months of earnest seeking, a new property became available. As our staff prayed for clarity, Tricia's phone chimed with the message, "The offer was accepted. You are under contract!"

This new center will allow us to serve more clients, expand programs, and provide a safe place for survivors to heal and rediscover their value. God has opened the door for hope and restoration.
